Mr Knocker, who declined a re-vet of the greyhound, pleaded guilty to the charge, Jecinta was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Cranbourne and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Final Chimes was vetted following the event. It was reported that the greyhound sustained a right hindleg thigh injury. No stand down period was imposed.
