Race 1

Cabin Fever was vetted following the event. It was reported that the greyhound sustained left and right deltoid injuries, a 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr D. Pell, the trainer of Cabin Fever regarding the greyhounds racing manners in the home straight. Acting under GAR 69(1) Stewards charged Cabin Fever with marring. Mr Pell pleaded not guilty to the charge, Cabin Fever was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Sandown and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Zara's Entity was vetted following the event. It was reported that the greyhound sustained a right sartorius injury, a 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Mr Jones pleaded guilty to the charge, La Vagabonde was found guilty and stewards directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a), before any future nomination will be accepted.
