Acting under GAR 69(A)(1) stewards charged Fabrebab with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Debattista pleaded guilty to the charge, Fabrebab was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.
