#### Race 1

SEQUENTIAL PROPERTY SERVICES

Sweet Harriet, Inga Mikey and Rose Mikado collided in the home straight.

Stewards spoke to the representative Mr V. Inguanti, regarding the greyhounds racing manners approaching the second turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(B)(1), Humble Inquiry was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Inguanti pleaded guilty to the charge, Humble Inquiry must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1) (a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race blood sample was taken from Black Canvas - winner of the event.

Handsome Jake crossed to the outside approaching the first turn checking Spot On Cinta, Closing Midnight, Miss Vonshae and Lady Oracle. Handsome Jake, Closing Midnight and Lady oracle collided on the first turn checking Closing Midnight and severely checking Handsome Jake.

Threadin' Mikado checked off Aston Verve in the back straight. Hadarah Bale and Takis Bale collided on the home turn. Hadarah Bale crossed in the home straight. Aston Verve veered in and marred Takis Bale in the home straight.

Aston Verve underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have right monkey muscle and left chest muscle injuries. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr D. Trewin, the representative of Aston Verve regarding the greyhounds racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(1) Aston Verve was charged with marring. Mr Trewin pleaded guilty to the charge, Aston Verve is suspended for 28 days at Meadows and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

#### Race 5

SKY RACING (NO CITY WINS) HT1 1:32 pm 525m Grade 5 Heat A pre-race urine sample was taken from Select All.

Wise Lewis and Spandau Ballet were slow to begin.

Our Rock Man and Strawberry Swirl collided soon after the start. Rocket Jax and Tiger Dusty collided soon after the start. Wise Lewis cheeked off Select All soon after the start. Stewards spoke to Mrs J. Sharp, the trainer of Spandau Ballet regarding its performance approaching the home turn. Stewards deemed the performance unsatisfactory, acting in accordance with GAR 71, Spandau Ballet must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Akina Harley, Why Not Pocket and Spring Value were slow to begin.

Medina, Koenigsegg One, Full Of Weetbix, I'm Easy Boys and Spring Value collided soon after the start checking Koenigsegg One and Spring Value. Go Slow Goldy, Why Not Pocket, Medina, Full Of Weetbox and I'm Easy Boys collided approaching the first turn checking Medina, Why Not Pockets and Full Of Weetbox. Akina Harley and Koenigsegg One collided approaching the first turn. Medina and Spring Value collided several times approaching the first turn and again on the first turn. Why Not Pockets raced wide approaching the second turn checking Full Of Weetbix, Medina and Spring Value. Koenigsegg One and Akina Harley collided in the back straight. Why Not Pockets and Full Of Weetbix collided in the back straight. Go Slowly Goldy lost ground approaching the third turn to the home turn. Spring Value checked off Go Slowy Goldy approaching the home turn. Why Not Pockets and Full Of Weetbix collided approaching the home turn.

Go Slow Goldy underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was re-examined following race 10 and was found to have bruising to the right back muscle. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.

Stewards spoke to Mr M Delbridge, the trainer of Go Slow Goldy regarding its performance approaching the third turn to the home turn. Stewards deemed the performance unsatisfactory, acting in accordance with GAR 71, Go Slow Goldy must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Medina underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a spike wound to the right hind. A 3 day stand down period was imposed.

A post-race blood sample was taken from I'm Easy Boys - winner of the event.

Supplementary Report: Go Slow Goldy was presented to the Craigeburn Veterinary Clinic on 29 June 2019 for an examination. The information received from that examination indictaed that Go Slow Goldy had a Garde 4 tear of the left triangle muscle at the time of this exam.

Ruby Girl and Little Tubbsy collided soon after the start checking Little Tubbsy and Why Not Peter. Kessler Bale, Ruby Girl and Little Tubbsy collided approaching the first turn. Why Not Peter and Stevie Dee collided approaching the first turn. Little Tubbsy crossed out approaching the second turn checking Why Not Peter, Stevie Dee and Kiss Me Razley. Adori checked off Ruby Girl on the third turn. Stevie Dee checked off Adori on the third turn. Kiss Me Razley checked off Little Tubbsy on the home turn. Adori and Stevie Dee collided in the home straight.

Mr Courts pleaded guilty to a charge under GAR 86(o), in that he negligently failed to catch the greyhounds Lucas The Great and Ruby Girl after the trainers of both greyhounds paid Mr Courts to do so. Mr Courts pleaded guilty, was found guilty, and fined \$200.

Stewards spoke to Mr G. Cowcher, the trainer of Ruby Girl regarding a verbal altercation with Mr B. Courts following this event and issued him with a warning.

A post-race blood sample was taken from For The Horde - winner of the event.

MEETING COMMENTS:

Lektra Spring – Performed a Stewards Satisfactory Trial as the greyhound was stood down from racing at Meadows for fail to chase. Weighing 32.1 kgs and beginning from box 3, Lektra Spring completed the 525mtrs trial distance in a time of 29.98. Lektra Spring placed 1st in a field of 4 winning by 20 lengths. Lektra Spring has been cleared to race at all tracks.
