Satisfactory Trial Results - Flying Action trialled over the 390m from box one, weight 27.7kg, the greyhound was placed second in a field of four. The time of the trial was 22.61, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 0.5L. Flying Action was cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results - Why Not Fletch trialled over the 390m from box four, weight 30.1kg, the greyhound was placed third in a field of four. The time of the trial was 22.61, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 0.75L. Why Not Fletch was cleared.

Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mr Cameron Hudson, the trainer of Mack Trident, regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Mack Trident last raced on 22 December 2017. Mr Hudson stated that the greyhound was returning from a right hock injury and left hip support. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Mack Trident trialled over the 390m from box eight, weight 35.1kg, the greyhound was placed fourth in a field of four. The time of the trial was 22.61, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 1.75L. Mack Trident was cleared.
