Conway, the trainer of Galloping Flash regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced. Galloping Flash last raced on 16 September 2018 and is returning from a left front toe injury. Pursuant to GAR 77A, Galloping Flash trialled over the 311mtrs from box 4, weight 31.0kgs, the greyhound was placed 3rd in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 18.02, the greyhound was beaten by a margin of 9 ½ lengths. Galloping Flash was Not Cleared.</p> <p>Satisfactory Trial Results (GAR 77A) - Stewards spoke to Mrs S Saunders, the owner of Boycey Road regarding the length of time since the greyhound last raced.
