Race 1

In accordance with the GRV Hot Weather Policy, this event was deemed Heat Affected. The outside temperature when kennels opened was 26.6 degrees, the inside kennel temperature was 20.0 degrees.

The outside temperature prior to this event was 29.5 degrees, the inside kennel temperature immediately prior to this event when the greyhounds were retrieved was 20.3 degrees

Pursuant to GAR 104 (7) Steward D. Barber did not act in any official capacity for this event.
