Weighing 29.1kg and beginning from box 1 beaten by 2.5 lengths. Crackerjack Des has been cleared to race all tracks except Bendigo.</p> <p>Anna Victorem – Was stood down from racing at Shepparton for failing to chaise due to injury. Weighing 26.7kg and beginning from box 3 beaten by 6.25 lengths. Anna Victorem has been cleared to race at all tracks.</p> <p>Dyna Carl – Was stood down from racing at Geelong for marring. Weighing 28.9kg and beginning from box 8 beaten by 3 lengths. Dyna Carl has been cleared to race all tracks except Geelong. Dyna Carl underwent a veterinary examination after falling in the catching pen. The greyhound experienced exhaustion . A 3 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
