Acting under GAR 69(A)(1) stewards charged Swag with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Formosa pleaded guilty to the charge, Swag was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warragul and it was directed that the greyhound perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.
