Race 1

Roman Girl was vetted following the event. It was reported that the greyhound sustained a left hock injury. A stand down period of 10 days was imposed.

Stewards spoke to the trainer Mr. D. Basile of greyhound, Roman Girl regarding the greyhounds performance. Mr Basile stated that the greyhound had trialled well last week at Bendigo and today's performance was due to the greyhounds injury that it received during the running of the event. Acting on their own observations, viewing all available footage and Mr. Basile's explanation Stewards took no further action.

Mr. Zeinert stated that the greyhound was resuming racing after being seasonal. Mr. Zeinert, also declared a new weight of 26.0kg for the greyhound in accordance with GAR 39(2). Plenty Of It last raced at 24.5kg.

Hook Along Fyler and Nana Denise were slow to begin. Plenty Of It and Miss White Wash collided soon after the start checking Miss White Wash which stumbled as a result. Plenty Of It, Hook Along Fyler and Nana Denise collided on the first turn checking Plenty Of It. Satisfactory Trial Results - Double Tax trialled over the 390mt from box 8, weight 34.5kg, the greyhound was placed 1st in a field of 4. The time of the trial was 21.85, the greyhound won by a margin of 7L. Double Tax was cleared.
