Trois Femmes – Performed a Stewards Satisfactory trial as the greyhound has not competed in an event for in excess of six months due to seasonal and change of kennels. Weighing 24.6kgs and beginning from box 1, Trios Femmes completed the 311mtrs trial distance in a time of 18.43. Trois Femmes placed 3rd in a field of 4 beaten by 2 ¼ lengths. Trois Femmes has been cleared to race.
