Mr. Mason reserved his plea to the charge, Billy Swagger was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted. Acting under GAR 75 (1) Stewards directed Mr. Mason to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Billy Swagger in the event which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.
