Evidence was taken from Shining Opals' trainer Mr Brent Merton and Racing Steward Mr Ian Taylor. Mr Merton accepted that the transport used by him today failed to comply with the GRV Transportation of Greyhounds Policy. The compliance issue was that a single door was not securely fixed to the frame of the trailer. Stewards noted Mr Merton's forthright admissions and of importance, that the greyhound was not transported in the compartment (it was a 4 berth trailer) that was faulty. The Stewards issued Mr Merton's with an official warning and ordered that he fix the trailer to the required standards of the Transportation of Greyhounds Policy, before using this vehicle again. Failing to correct the issue will result in more punitive</p>
