Mikayla's Bella faltered approaching the 150m mark. Stamped Urgent faltered approaching the 100m mark and at the 50m mark.</p> <p>Stamped Urgent underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the left pencil muscle, the right quadricep and the right hock. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Mikayla's Bella underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hip injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.</p>

The winning time of the trial was 16.82:</p> <p>Weetbix Talent finished 2nd, Mia Tesoro finished 4th, Juniper Pearl finished 3rd.</p> <p>Weetbix Talent – The greyhound has not competed in an event for in excess of six months due to a spell. Weighing 34.9kgs and beginning from box number 1, beaten by 1 length. Weetbix Talent has been cleared to race all tracks.</p> <p>Mia Tesoro – The greyhound has not competed in an event for in excess of six months due to a spell. Weighing 25.1kgs and beginning from box number 3, beaten by 6.5 lengths. Mia Tesoro has been cleared</p>

to race all tracks.

Juniper Pearl – The greyhound has not competed in an event for in excess of six months due to a spell. Weighing 28.8kgs and beginning from box number 8, beaten by 2 lengths. Juniper Pearl has been cleared to race all tracks.
