MEETING COMMENTS:

The following greyhounds performed a Stewards Satisfactory Trial – The trial took place over 311mtrs with 4 required to trial. The winning time of trial was 17.91:

Ziping Caesar finished 1st, Blair Bale finished 2nd, Easy Tash finished 3rd.

Blair Bale - Was stood down from racing at Cranbourne for fail to chase injury Weighing 25.7kgs and beginning from box 1 beaten by 2 ¼ lengths. Blair Bale has been cleared to race all tracks.

Easy Tash – Performed a Stewards Satisfactory Trial as connections wish to apply blinkers to the greyhound. Easy Tash was also stood down from racing at Sale for fail to chase. Weighing 28.3kgs and beginning from box 4 beaten by 6 lengths. Easy Tash has been cleared to race all tracks except Sale.

Ziping Caesar – Was stood down from racing at Warragul for cramping. Weighing 36.2kgs and beginning from box 8 winning by 2 ¼ lengths. Ziping Caesar has been cleared to race at all tracks.
