After considering all the evidence, Stewards charged Mr McDonald with a breach of GAR 27 (1) in that he did not have proper control of a greyhound on a racecourse. The greyhound underwent a veterinary examination prior to racing and was passed fit to race. Stewards found Mr McDonald guilty as charged and fined him the sum of \$100. In considering penalty, Stewards took into consideration Mr McDonald's longevity of over 60 years in the greyhound industry.</p> <p>Levy's Banjo – New declared weight of 33.1kg, last raced at 31.9kg.</p> <p>Iles Inn and Spot On Mick were slow to begin and collided soon after the start.
