Race 1

SILVER EAGLE OUTFITTERS 11:17 am 300m Maiden Due to Government Social Distancing Laws under COVID-19 and acting in accordance with GAR 51 (10), the Stewards have directed that the boxing process in Victoria will revert to and continue under the 4-wave model being 1 & 5 boxed first, followed by 3 & 7, followed by 2 & 6, followed by 4 & 8. Handlers are required to exit the area after boxing and maintain their 1.5m distance from other handlers and staff at all times.

All persons (both Staff & Participants) attending today, undertook successful health screenings that in-turn, permitted entry to the venue for exclusive race-day functions and operations.

Pat's Me Mum and Mt. View Molly collided soon after start. Montoya and Ultra High collided soon after start. Swashbuckler and Bella Boom collided soon after the start. Swashbuckler crossed to the outside at the 150m mark. Pat's Me Mum lost ground at the 50m mark.

Stewards spoke to Mr. Donald Jarvis, the Trainer of Pat's Me Mum regarding the greyhound's racing manners at the 50m mark. Mr Jarvis told Stewards that he had trialled the greyhound on three occasions at Healesville, but has been unable to trial the greyhound in a full field given the latest trialling regulations. After viewing both the patrol and head-on video footage, Stewards issued Mr. Jarvis a warning regarding the greyhound's racing manners at the 50m mark.
