Meeting comments:

Stewards opened and finalised an inquiry from the Geelong Greyhound Racing Club Meeting on Friday, 15th November 2019 where registered Trainer, Mr Troy Scott failed to retrieve the greyhound Fonzarelli, engaged in Race 11, prior to leaving the course. After taking evidence, Stewards charged Mr Scott pursuant to GAR 86 (o) with the particulars of the charge being, that he left the course before retrieving the greyhound Fonzarelli, which in the opinion of the Stewards, was negligent. Mr Scott pleaded guilty to the charge. Mr Scott was found guilty and was fined the sum of \$200, \$100 of which was suspended for twelve months, pending no further breaches. In assessing penalty, Stewards took into account Mr Scott's guilty plea, his record and his personal circumstances on the night.
