Race 2 CHENERY PLUMBING 7:23 pm 390m Tier 3 - Maiden	<p>Plenty Of It – New declared weight of 24.5kg, last raced at 25.8kg.</p> <p>Pursuant to GAR 104 (6) Starter Mr J.LaRosa did not act in any official capacity that may have in any way, affected the outcome of this event.</p> <p>Plenty Of It visibly eased soon after the start. Dyna Carl checked off Gallant Toby on the first turn, checking Calzone. Dyna Carl and Serendipity Judy collided entering the home straight.</p> <p>Plenty Of It underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right thigh and right hip muscle injury. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr FZeinert, the trainer of Plenty Of It regarding the greyhounds racing manners soon after the start. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(A)(1) Plenty Of It was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Zeinert pleaded guilty to the charge, Plenty Of It is suspended for 28 days at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Gallant Toby - the winner of the event.</p>
