Chilcott, the representative of Greysynd Cruise regarding the greyhounds racing manners on the home turn and entering the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(1) Greysynd Cruise was charged with marring. Mr Chilcott pleaded guilty to the charge, Greysynd Cruise is suspended for 28 days at Warragul and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2) (a) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>

Mr Kipirtidis pleaded guilty to the charge, Come On Levendi is suspended for 3 months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(A)(2)(b) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
