Mother Hannah placed 1st in a field of 4 starters winning by 15.75L Mother Hannah has been cleared to race at all tracks except Ballarat.

Chantilly Mack – Performed a Stewards Satisfactory Trial as the greyhound was stood down from racing at Sandown for unsatisfactory performance. Weighing 32.5kgs and beginning from box 8, Chantilly Mack completed the 400m trial distance in a time of 23.44. Chantilly Mack placed 3rd in a field of 4 starters beaten by 17.5L Chantilly Mack has been cleared to race at all tracks except Sandown.
