In accordance with GAR 51 (10), the Stewards have directed the Starter to ensure the greyhounds are boxed in a single file boxing process, commencing with box 1, followed by box 2, followed by box 3 etc. Greyhounds with a box first endorsement will continue to be boxed first All handlers must maintain a 2 metre distance from the handler in front during the loading process.

Dress code - All participants that are permitted on course, as per the attendance regulations, must be dressed in accordance with the dress code as set out in the rules (ie; black and whites) at all times – including kennelling

Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr. V. Millington regarding the race manner of Solar Tiny in the home straight. Mr Millington explained that the greyhound was having its first start at Ballarat however he expected the greyhound to perform better than what it did. Mr Millington's comments were noted. A warning was issued against the greyhound's racing manner in the home straight.

Southern Meteor underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Trainer Mr. D Klemke regarding the greyhounds racing manners entering the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(1) Southern Meteor was charged with marring. Mr. D Klemke pleaded guilty to the charge, Southern Meteor is suspended for 3 months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2)(b) before any future nomination will be accepted.
