A 5 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>You Fugitive underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion to the left scapula and metacarpal and soreness in the right hock, right thigh and left shoulder. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Gleeson underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left scapula injury. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
