Handlers are required to exit the area after boxing and maintain their 1.5m distance from other handlers and staff at all times.</p> <p>All persons (both Staff &amp; Participants) attending today, undertook successful health screenings and wore face-masks/covers that in-turn, permitted entry to the venue for exclusive race-day functions and operations.</p> <hr/> <p>Golden Ration was slow to begin. You Ember was quick to begin and crossed to the rails soon after the start checking Minter Explode, Write About Her, Polarising and Token Supreme. Minter Explode, Polarising and Token Supreme collided on the first turn checking Lawful Man. Write About Her checked off Token Supreme on the first turn causing Write About Her and Ton Eighty to race wide. Token Supreme and Golden Ratio collided on the second turn checking Token Supreme. Lawful Man and Golden Ratio collided entering the back straight. Token Supreme galloped on Golden Ratio entering the back straight checking Golden Ratio and Write About Her. Write About Her raced wide in the back straight. Minter Explode checked off You Ember on the home turn. Stewards noted that the muzzle of Minter Explode became dislodged during the event.</p>
