Handlers are required to exit the area after boxing and maintain their 1.5m distance from other handlers and staff at all times.

All persons (both Staff & Participants) attending today, undertook successful health screenings and wore face-masks/coverings that in-turn, permitted entry to the venue for exclusive race-day functions and operations.

Mr. Julian pleaded guilty to the charge, Crumb Snags must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.
