In accordance with GAR 75 (1), the Stewards requested Ms. Dudley to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Jimmy Goes Bang in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event. A post-race sample was taken from Atomic Icon - winner of the event. Supplementary Report Jimmy Goes Bang - Subsequent to the race meeting Trainer Ms R. Dudley advised that the greyhound was examined and found to have a left thigh, right triangle and right quadriceps injury. Ms Dudley advised that the greyhound would have a brief let up prior to racing again.
