Jodie's Boy underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported.

Stewards spoke to Ms P. Marek , the handler of Jodie's Boy regarding the greyhounds racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(1) Jodie's Boy was charged with marring. Ms Marek pleaded guilty to the charge, Jodie's Boy is suspended for 28 days at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Ginger Meggs underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported.

Mr Vantaarling pleaded guilty to the charge, Twilight Flame is suspended for 28 days at Shepparton and must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks), pursuant to GAR 69(2)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Strike Out underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a broken toe on the left foreleg. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.
