Handlers are required to exit the area after boxing and maintain their 1.5m distance from other handlers and staff at all times.</p> <p>All persons (both Staff & Participants) attending today, undertook successful health screenings and wore face-masks that in-turn, permitted entry to the venue for exclusive race-day functions and operations.</p> <hr/> <p>This event was delayed by approximately 2 minutes due to operational matters.</p> <p>Roller Derby was quick to begin.
