Mr Cortese pleaded guilty to the charge; Coughlin's Law must perform a Satisfactory Trial (all tracks) pursuant to GAR 69(B)(1)(a) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>

Stewards charged Mr.Galea with a breach of GAR 86(q). Mr Galea pleaded not guilty to the charge. Mr. Galea was found guilty and fined \$250.</p>
