Nunniong Bear, Lainey Zapper and Smoking Syd collided soon after the start checking Lainey Zapper. Boes High Five, Zero and Tibetan collided at the 300m mark checking Zero and Tibetan; Boes High Five, crossed to the outside as a result. Nunniong Bear, Smoking Syd and Raquea's Dream collided approaching the 250m mark. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr Tony Tufo, the trainer of What A Kicker regarding the greyhound's racing manners approaching the 150m mark. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69(1) What A Kicker was charged with marring. Mr Tufo pleaded guilty, to the charge, What A Kicker was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Healesville and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69(2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
