Scott Worth It underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the left deltoid muscle and right calf muscle. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Ms Emma Bowles, the trainer of Scott Worth It regarding the greyhound's racing manners approaching the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1) Scott Worth It was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Ms Bowles pleaded not guilty to the charge, Scott Worth It was found guilty and suspended for 3 months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69A(2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
