Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr Trevor Whitford regarding the greyhounds racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), Mt. View Ivy was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Whitford pleaded guilty to the charge, Mt. View Ivy was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
