Acting in accordance with GAR 37 (1), Stewards conducted a kennelling veterinary examination on the majority of greyhounds engaged in todays race meeting until the arrival of the GRV on-course veterinarian.

Trickity Click was very slow to begin - 4 lengths.

Custom Roof faltered at the 150m mark.

Custom Roof underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have injuries to the left monkey muscle and left pectoral muscle. A7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Ms Shelly-Ann Warde, the trainer of Custom Roof regarding. In accordance with GAR 75 (1), the Stewards requested Ms Warde to report as soon as practicable anything that may have affected the running of Custom Roof in the event, which was not noted by Stewards during or immediately after the event.

Trickity Click underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported.

A post-race sample was taken from More Speed - the winner of the event.

Stewards spoke to handler, Ms Lori Courts regarding the greyhounds racing manners approaching the winning post. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), Mepunga Reject was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms Courts pleaded guilty to the charge, Mepunga Reject was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
