Stewards spoke to Kennel Representitive Mr Daniel Gibbons regarding the greyhound's racing manners entering the turn off the back straight, on the second occasion. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Rohan Bale was charged with failling to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Gibbons pleaded not guilty to the charge, Rohan Bale was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 125, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.
