Acting under the provisions of GAR 124 Miss Rhubarb was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mrs Torr pleaded guilty to the charge, Miss Rhubarb was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 127, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> |
