Race 1

Stewards spoke to Ms Holly Thompson, the trainer of Lakeview Lottie regarding its performance in the home straight. After hearing submissions from Ms Thompson, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, the Stewards deemed the performance of Lakeview Lottie unsatisfactory. Lakeview Lottie must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 129, and pursuant to GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.

5:19 pm 440m Maiden Felena – Late scratching at 16:05 due to weight variation (GAR 101). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Trainer, Mr. Chris Johannsen was fined \$100.

A pre-race sample was taken from Awesome Isla.

Harada's Mate was quick to begin.

Stewards spoke to representative Mr. Dermott Prout of Harada's Mate after the greyhound underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed Harada's Mate to have suffered a seizure. Acting under the provisions of GAR 42, Harada's Mate is prohibited from competing in an event until such time as both a veterinary clearance is provided to the satisfaction of Stewards and a satisfactory trial is completed, pursuant to GAR 132. Further, under the provisions of GAR 42 (3)Harada's Mate, is suspended from racing for 28 days at all tracks.
