Internal Affairs – Late scratching at 8:01am when Mr. A Azzopardi reported the greyhound to have diarrhoea(GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Stone – Late scratching at 8:49am when Ms. S Grenfell reported the greyhound to have tail injury (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(w) before any future nomination will be accepted.

Race 2

thephoenix.melbourne HT1 11:52 am 525m Mixed 6/7 Heat Ox The Man and Fitzroy Bale were quick to begin. Wheel And Go and Bilali were slow to begin.

A post-race sample was taken from Wheel And Go - the winner of the event.

TOPCAT VIDEO HT2 12:09 pm 525m Mixed 6/7 Heat Red's Shout was quick to begin. Lights Strike was slow to begin.

Race 4

HOME OF 10 G1S HT3 12:30 pm 525m Mixed 6/7 Heat Stewards held the All Clear after a greyhound that had fallen on the first turn, ran back into the field resulting in the lure having to be pulled up. After reviewing all available video footage and acting on their observations the Stewards were not satisfied that the incident had no effect on the outcome of the race and as such, pursuant to GAR 110, declared the event to be a 'No Race'. All bets are refunded. The weights recorded for the greyhounds are void and do not count for the purposes of the weight rule at the greyhounds' next start. The event was then abandoned, with prizemoney to be split evenly between the greyhounds which competed.

The Stewards made no orders in accordance with GAR 111(2)(a). As the event was a heat of a series, the Stewards conducted a random public ballot to determine the two greyhounds to participate in the final on 9th July 2022 in accordance with GAR 111(2)(b). The following greyhound/s progressed to the final:

- 1. Rothwell Random
- 2. Chloe's China

Major Lighting fell entering the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a scapula fracture. A 60 day stand down period was imposed.

Aston Oscar fell entering the first turn, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a monkey muscle injury and laceration to its right stopper. A7 day stand down period was imposed.

Natteo Bale faltered entering the back straight, underwent a post–race veterinary examination and was found to have a left deltoid injury. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Trial 1 -

Story Unfolds - Veterinary Clearance – Solo, Distance 525m, Weight 36.1kg, Box 3, Time: 30.496 – Comment: Not Cleared to Race.

Stewards spoke to Mr. B. Loft, trainer of Story Unfolds due to the greyhound having a seizure in the catching pen. A post-trial veterinary examination revealed that Story Unfolds suffered from a seizure in the catching pen. A 28 day stand down period was imposed. Acting under the provisions of GAR 42, Story Unfolds is prohibited from competing in an event until such time as both a veterinary clearance is provided to the satisfaction of Stewards and a satisfactory trial is completed, pursuant to GAR 132. Further, under the provisions of GAR 42 (3) Story Unfolds is suspended from racing for 3 months, at all tracks.
