Emma's Image shifted out and visibly eased on the third turn checking Bobby Bull Shark and Jessie's Image.

Bobby Bull Shark underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a left carpal sprain and a right calf injury, a 7 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative, Mrs Simone Fisher regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the second turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), Bobby Bull Shark was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mrs. Fisher pleaded guilty to the charge, Bobby Bull Shark was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B(1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Emma's Image underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mrs. Julie Chilcott, the representative regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the second and third turns. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1), Emma's Image was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mrs. Chilcott pleaded guilty to the charge, Emma's Image was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at The Meadows and must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 69A(2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race sample was taken from Trenzalore - winner of the event.

Mr. Jarvis pleaded not guilty to the charge, Rufiano was found guilty and suspended for 3 months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69(2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
