Stewards issued Mr. Girvasi with a warning pursuant to GAR 42 (2). Mr. Girvasi returned to the Cranbourne Racing Club where Inga Daisy underwent a post race veterinary examination and was found to have a spike wound on the left calf. A3 day stand down period was imposed.

Teddy Too underwent a post race veterinary examination and was found to have an injured right hock. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to trainer, Mr. Shaun Hughes regarding the greyhound's racing manners on the first turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1) Teddy Too was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Hughes pleaded guilty to the charge, Teddy Too was found guilty and suspended for 12 months at all tracks and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69A(2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
