Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1) Purple Storm was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr Wright pleaded guilty to the charge, Purple Storm was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Warrnambool and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69A(2) and GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
