A 3 day stand down period was imposed.</p> <p>Max Fawn underwent a post-race veterinary examination following a severe check on the first turn and was found to have an abraded left hind webbing. A 3 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr John Bosnich the trainer of Max Fawn after the greyhound lost considerable ground over the concluding stages of the event. After hearing evidence from Mr Hanke, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, a warning was issued.</p> <p>Rare Sapphire underwent a post-race veterinary examination after the greyhound collided with Affair Beauty several times and lost ground over the concluding stages of the event - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to Mr Reginald Marriner regarding the racing manners on the third turn. After hearing evidence from Mr Marriner, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, a warning was issued.</p> <p>My Name's Phil underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a contusion to the left tibia and abrasions to the right hind toes, a 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Shelly-Ann Warde, regarding the greyhounds racing manners on the second turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), My Name's Phil was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Ms Warde pleaded guilty to the charge, My Name's Phil was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p>
