Stewards spoke to Mr Mark Giddings, the trainer regarding the greyhounds racing manners on the home turn. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), Zipping Blossom was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Giddings pleaded guilty to the charge, Zipping Blossom was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
