Mr. Duncan pleaded guilty to the charge, Chill Out Berty was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.

A post-race urine sample was unable to be obtained, a blood sample was subsequently taken from Reiko Bingle - winner of the event.
