Race 1 BENDIGO ADVERTISER (250+RANK) 2:12 pm 500m Maiden	Essential persons (both staff & participants) attending today, provided satisfactory evidence of vaccination or exemption under the State Government's mandatory vaccination (workers) directions, undertook successful health screenings, wore facemasks, observed social distance requirements, and adhered to room density quotients that in-turn, permitted entry to the venue for exclusive race-day functions and operations.
	An out of competition sample was taken from Dragon Slayer on 28/10/21 pursuant to GAR 79A. Diversify was quick to begin. Trending Striker and Saint Bogan were slow to begin and collided soon after the start. Baffling, Blazing Health and Blue Sadie collided approaching the first turn. Blazing Beth checked off Dragon Slayer entering the back straight. Baffling and Blazing Beth collided on the second turn checking Blazing Beth. Diversify and Trending Striker collided on the home turn and again in the home straight. Diversify visably eased and turned it's head to the inside in the home straight. Diversify underwent a post-race veterinary examination and re-vetted following race 4. It was reported that Diversify sustained an injury to the right groin. A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Mr. John Mangion, the trainer of Diversify regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1) Diversify was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr. Mangion pleaded quilty to the charge. Diversify was found quilty and
	suspended for 28 days at Bendigo and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69A (2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.
