Stewards deemed the performance unsatisfactory, acting in accordance with GAR 71, Collaboration must perform a Satisfactory Trial pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Ebonique underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a fractured left hock. Ebonique was humanely euthanized

A pre-race sample was unable to be obtained from Midnight Storm, a post-race sample was subsequently taken.

MEETING COMMENTS:

Stewards were advised that the track was medium harrowed on Thursday 4th November 2021.

Pursuant to GAR 31, Ms Julie Belsham was issued with a warning for failing to have all greyhounds kennelled by the appointed close of kennelling time.
