Acting under the provisions of GAR 69A(1) Humanity was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment. Mr De Rozario pleaded guilty to the charge. Humanity was found guilty and suspended for 28 days at Traralgon and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69A (2) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken from Zipping Hunter - the winner of the event.</p>
