Acting under the provisions of GAR 69B (1), Yor Embrace was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mr Howat pleaded guilty to the charge, Your Embrace was found guilty and must perform a Satisfactory Trial in accordance with GAR 69B (1) and pursuant to GAR 72, before any future nomination will be accepted.

Silver Harp (fell) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an injury to the left triangle muscle. A 10 day stand down period was imposed.

Mayhem Thrill (check) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have shin soreness on the right fore leg. A 14 day stand down period was imposed.

Aston Shadow (severely checked) underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have cramped post race. A 5 day stand down period was imposed
