A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(v) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Stewards spoke to Mr. Justin Bowman regarding the time of the withdrawal of Agronomous and reminded Mr. Bowman that prior to the appointed scratching time of an event a greyhound is engaged to compete in, the greyhound must be examined to ensure that it is free of both injury and Illness GAR 76 (1)(a).</p> <p>Chief Gem – Late scratching at 6:23pm due to the greyhound not being presented (non-arrival) (GAR 86 and LR 39). Due to the circumstances surrounding the non-presentation of Chief Gem, the 28 day stand down period was imposed on the greyhound. Trainer, Kym Russell was fined \$250.</p>
