<b>Race 1</b> GREYHOUND ADOPTION PROGRAM 11:02 am 450m Tier 3 - Maiden	Lala Ornament was slow to begin.
<b>Race 2</b> A1 SIGNAGE 11:18 am 390m Tier 3 - Maiden	<p>Prince Of Melton – Late scratching at 7.30am when Trainer Mr M. Giddings reported the greyhound to have an infection (GAR 76). A 10 day stand down period was imposed. Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(v) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>Who Told Sarah and Xanthi Bale were quick to begin. Neptune Town was slow to begin.</p> <p>Hey Tootle underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have an abrasion to the left hind leg, no stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to Trainer Mrs. E. Steel regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. Acting under the provisions of GAR 125, Hey Tootle was charged with failing to pursue the lure with due commitment (by reason of injury). Mrs Steele pleaded guilty to the charge, Hey Tootle must perform a satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 125 and GAR 132, before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A post-race sample was taken Who Told Sarah - the winner of the event.</p>

Iverson was slow to begin.</p> <p>Sher Burgundy underwent a post-race veterinary examination - no apparent injury was reported. Stewards spoke to representative Ms. K. Heinrich regarding the greyhound pulling up prior to the return gate and crossing the infield, a warning was issued against the greyhound.</p>

Stewards will require a veterinary certificate pursuant to GAR 19(3)(v) before any future nomination will be accepted.</p> <p>A pre-race sample was taken from Champ Cheese.</p> <p>Jebrynah Umida was quick to begin. Lily Rose Harper and Mahogany Flame were slow to begin.</p>

Grade 5 T3	<p>Ollie underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have minor spike wounds to the right hind leg and left hind toes, a three day stand down period was imposed. Stewards spoke to representative Ms. E. Frost regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight. After hearing evidence from Ms Frost, viewing the available race footage and acting on their observations, a warning was issued regarding the greyhound's racing manners in the home straight.</p> <p>My Golden Eagle fell passing the finishing post, underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a right hind tarsal sprain. A 7 day stand down period was imposed.</p>
