O'Neill regarding the behaviour of Nelly Intention in pulling up before the return gate and not entering the catching pen. The Stewards hold concerns that this poses an unnecessary safety issue for Nelly Intention, other greyhounds in the race, and staff that triage these types of incidents. After considering submissions from Ms O'Neill, a warning was issued that further such instances of this nature may result in Nelly Intention being placed on a conditional satisfactory trial in accordance with GAR 129.
